Bus routes, created by our transportation provider Durham School Services, are one example of several major changes taking place this year. The staff at the Construction Careers Center is pleased you are a Bobcat this year and able to take advantage of all that we have worked to accomplish in our short summer of planning.

As the new School Leader (Principal) I have worked hard with the staff at CCC to improve your high school experience. The Construction Department will provide opportunities for meaningful projects that will increase in rigor throughout high school; our Student Support Services Team lead by our Dean of School Culture will ensure a safe, fun and orderly environment for all students; and increased transparency from our Guidance Counselor will assist you with your four-year graduation goal. We are moving in a new and proud direction at CCC!

The staff at CCC is pleased to include in this mailer your bus routes and schedules. Bus routes designate your pick-up and drop-off locations and times.
